[Course contents]

- 1 **Introduction** (motivation/from Big Bang to life on Earth; evolution; human body; neuroscience).
- 2 **Knowledge, Nature, Science and Scimat** (two kinds of knowledge: human independent and human dependent; idea of Nature; idea of science; scimat the new discipline; science and scientist defined)
- 3 **Science and Scimat, Again** (science in a nutshell; how science was and is done: simple systems and complex systems; time evolution of scientific process and scientific results; essence of science; reality check; scimat implications)
- 4 **History** (what is history; methods to study history: empirical, phenomenological and bottom-up approaches; history in the future)
- 5 **Arts** (Origin of arts; nature of arts: applied arts and pure arts; five criteria of pure arts; arts as science matters; arts and science)
- Philosophy (historical developments; consistency with existing science; neurophilosophy; experimental philosophy)
- 7 How to do good research and to write a scientific article in English.
